TheraClear[®]X Acne Therapy System is indicated for the treatment of mild-to-moderate acne, including comedonal, pustular, and inflammatory acne vulgaris on all skin types

TREATMENT EXPECTATIONS

- Treatment regimen consists of 4-6 in-office treatments (depending on the severity of the acne) scheduled 10-14 days (about 2 weeks) apart
- Treatments usually take 10-20 minutes, require no downtime, and are pain-free
- Visible improvement in acne lesions can be seen as early as the second treatment
- Significant and consistent reductions in acne lesion counts at each treatment is observed in most patients. Clearance rates may vary as individuals react differently to the treatment
- Patients also observe improved overall skin texture with a reduction in oiliness of their skin, reduced pore size, and decreased redness

POSSIBLE SIDE EFFECTS

- Localized, mild and transient erythema that typically resolves within 30 minutes
- Mild bruising or minor purpura that resolves 24-72 hours post-treatment
- Some patients may experience an acne flare after their first treatment
- Some patients might experience slight increase in dryness
- Rarely some patients might experience pigmentary changes (hyperpigmentation or hypopigmentation) that typically resolves over time without intervention

PRE-TREATMENT INSTRUCTIONS

- Skin should be clean and dry when you arrive for your appointment. Do not apply any medications, creams, or lotions etc.
- Review any side effects of prior treatments with the clinician
- Wear protective eyewear provided by the clinician

POST-TREATMENT INSTRUCTIONS

- Schedule the next appointment before leaving the office
- Keep treated areas free from excessive sun exposure between treatment sessions or wear mineral-based sunblock
- Treat your skin as you usually would and apply any medications, creams, lotions, etc.
- Do not stop your current medications unless instructed by your physician
- Inform your physician if you start a new medication or make changes to your current medications
